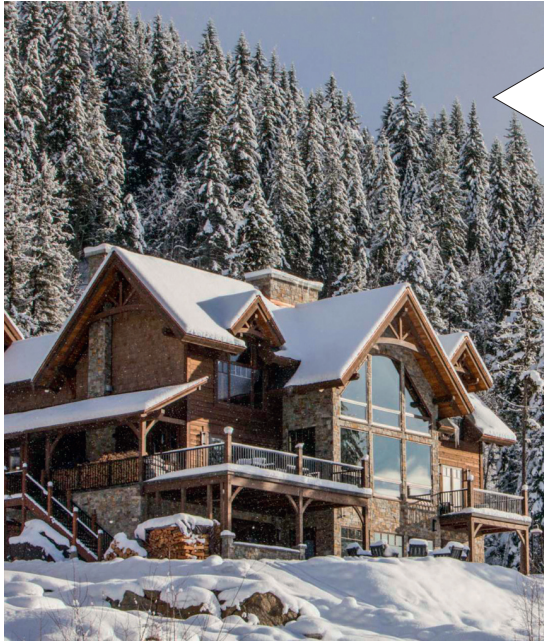

Ski chalets



BISON LODGE, REVELSTOKE, CANADA

A one-minute ski from the gondola that serves North America's longest run, this supersized chalet is positioned right in the heart of the world's heli-skiing Mecca. An 8.5-metre climbing wall takes centre stage and serves as the perfect après alternative, should your ski legs allow. Spectators can watch from sink-in sofas under the gaze of a bison trophy head. pelorusx.com



CHALET ZERMATT PEAK, ZERMATT, SWITZERLAND

Forget the master bedroom – the crown jewel of this lofty six-storey residence is a glass-roofed "gallery suite" offering mountain views by day and a starry sky by night. Ski boots are heated in a subterranean boot room, while a 300-bottle wine cellar is thought to be one of the finest private collections in Zermatt. ultimateluxurychalets.com

SCARP RIDGE LODGE, COLORADO, US

Don't be fooled by the Wild West façade – this former miners' watering hole is now a rustic, family-style ski lodge with a saltwater pool and oxygen-enriched air system to aid those arriving straight from sea level. For the adventurous at heart, the property's souped-up snowcats will whisk you to and from the mountain each day, with 400 hectares of backcountry and champagne powder to explore. elevenexperience.com



CHALECH S., LECH, AUSTRIA

The resort of choice for well-heeled skiers, it's not uncommon to find yourself rubbing shoulders with royalty in Lech. One of the hottest new properties to open its doors is a picture-perfect Alpine chalet set over four floors, with a Roman baths-style tepidarium and lap pool at your disposal. Expect superyacht-style service, with staff – wearing traditional Austrian dirndls – on hand with a glass of fizz or piping hot Glühwein to warm up cold bones. brambleski.com
